Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- use current multimedia equipment and programs
- assist others to use multimedia equipment and programs
- correct minor operational faults
- report on use of multimedia equipment and programs and make recommendations for upgrading.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- explain range of current multimedia options relevant to the work context at a generalist level
- describe features and general operating functions of different multimedia options
- list common faults and ways of rectifying these in multimedia equipment and programs used
- outline scope of repair and maintenance activities that can be undertaken without specialist assistance
- identify sources of information on multimedia equipment and programs
- explain conditions of current licences and equipment maintenance agreements.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in the Library – Multimedia Technology field of work and include access to:

- current range of multi-media equipment and programs and associated software applications
- audiovisual equipment.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational education and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
