- components of project scope management plans including:
 - established change control procedures
 - performance measurement indicators
- factors likely to impact project scope
- procedures relating to scope change including:
 - formal change-control processes
 - reporting change
- methods for measuring work outcomes and progress against plans
- methods for reviewing project outcomes
- scope control methods

- types of project initiation documentation.

- project documentation which includes information about project scope.
