Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- conduct an investigation of current water usage practices for an organisation, including:
 - water sources
 - how water is used
 - actual and projected water usage
- research and analyse cost benefits of potential improvements to current practices
- report on final recommendations for water efficient practices.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- identify the available water sources
- explain how water quality affects what it can be used for
- outline legislative and organisational requirements regarding the access and use of water
- outline new technology for water efficient practices
- outline alternative sources for obtaining potable water
- explain the principles of conducting a cost-benefit analysis.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in the sustainability field of work and include access to:

- relevant information about legislative requirements

- relevant workplace documentation
- case studies or, where possible, real situations.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational education and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
