- facilitate at least three group discussions, including:
  - using a range of group facilitation strategies to enhance interactions between group members and to gather relevant feedback
  - providing feedback to the group regarding outcomes.

- communication styles and techniques
- principles of effective community engagement and participation
- community engagement techniques including online tools and use of social media
- methods of research
- capacity building
- evaluation and review
- building and maintaining partnerships
- social capital
- reporting mechanisms
- re-engagement strategies for individuals who are disengaged
- organisational policies and procedures for:
  - responding to questions and concerns
  - documentation.

## Assessment Conditions

Skills must be demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions.

Assessment must ensure:

- access to facilities, equipment and resources that reflect real working conditions and model industry operating conditions and contingencies

- access to organisational policies and procedures
- opportunities for engagement with community stakeholders.

Assessors must satisfy the Standards for Registered Training Organisations' requirements for assessors.
