# Assessment Requirements for CHCSOH020 Develop quality systems in line with registration standards

## Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to complete tasks outlined in elements and performance criteria of this unit in the context of the job role, and:

- develop and document policies, procedures and systems for one social housing organisation compliant with current community housing registration standards
- identify one organisational risk and establish and communicate strategies, control measures and continuous improvement processes to address it.

## Knowledge Evidence

Demonstrated knowledge required to complete the tasks outlined in elements and performance criteria of this unit:

- continuous improvement principles
- quality assurance principles
- good governance principles:
  - conduct of governing body and employees
  - privacy and confidentiality of information
  - transparency and accountability in dealings
  - management of conflicts of interest
- issues impacting long term financial viability:
  - solvency and cash flow
  - income variability
  - ongoing expenditure
  - financial reporting requirements
- current Commonwealth and State or Territory community housing registration standards
- techniques for developing organisational policies, procedures, systems and standards for:
  - documentation and record keeping
  - risk management
  - staff management
  - tenancy management
  - property management and maintenance

- principles of accountability, policy formation, development of strategy, compliance, and monitoring and review.

## **Assessment Conditions**

Skills must be demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions.

Assessment must ensure:

- access to suitable facilities, equipment and resources that reflect real working conditions and model industry operating conditions and contingencies
- access to current Commonwealth and State or Territory community housing registration standards
- opportunities for engagement with diverse clients.

Assessors must satisfy the Standards for Registered Training Organisations' requirements for assessors.
