Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to complete tasks outlined in elements and performance criteria of this unit in the context of the job role, and:

- collect, analyse and review evidence and programs to determine the need for a specific youth program
- prepare at least one youth program plan, including:
 - outlining activities and actions
 - determining operational arrangements
 - calculating costs, space and resources
 - assessing feasibility
 - developing implementation and evaluation strategies
- implement at least one youth program, adapt the youth program to the changing needs of participants and evaluate the outcomes, including:
 - using evaluation techniques and reporting outcomes to young people and stakeholders in an accessible format.

Knowledge Evidence

Demonstrated knowledge required to complete the tasks outlined in elements and performance criteria of this unit:

- target groups relevant to the work context and the program
- types and content of common youth activities and programs relevant to the work context
- legal and safety requirements as they relate to youth activities and programs
- strategies and techniques for evaluation of youth programs
- funding sources for youth programs
- organisational policies and procedures
- techniques for writing complete and accurate reports.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must be demonstrated in the workplace, with the addition of simulations and scenarios where the full range of contexts and situations have not been provided in the workplace.

Assessment must ensure:

- access to facilities, equipment and resources that reflect real working conditions and model industry operating conditions and contingencies
- access to organisational policies and procedures
- opportunities for engagement with young people.

Assessors must satisfy the Standards for Registered Training Organisations' requirements for assessors.
