Performance Evidence

To demonstrate competency in this unit, a candidate must safely and effectively, across three different carpentry tasks, use and maintain all of the listed tools and equipment at least once:

- hand tools:
 - retractable tape measure
 - folding or steel ruler
 - combination square
 - string line
 - chalk line
 - hand saw
 - coping saw
 - carpenters hammer / claw hammer
 - wood chisel
 - hand plane
 - trimming knife
 - clamps
 - bevels
 - spirit level
 - tin snips
- power/battery/pneumatic tools and equipment:
 - circular saw
 - reciprocating saw
 - sliding compound saw

- jigsaw
- angle grinder
- planer
- laminate trimmer or router
- drill
- rotary hammer drill
- impact driver
- nail gun
- bench grinder
- extension lead
- portable residual current device
- air compressor and hoses.

The candidate must also:

- replace blades/cutters/grinding discs in:
 - a power saw
 - a powered planer
 - a router
 - grinder
- grind, sharpen and hone a hand plane blade
- grind, sharpen and hone a chisel.

To be competent in this unit, a candidate must demonstrate knowledge of:

- workplace quality policies and standards for using carpentry tools and equipment
- safety requirements for using carpentry tools and equipment
- types of tools and equipment and their characteristics, uses and limitations:
 - hand tools including:
 - retractable tape measure
 - folding or steel ruler
 - combination square
 - spirit level
 - string line
 - chalk line
 - hand saw
 - coping saw
 - carpenters hammer/claw hammer
 - wood chisel
 - hand plane

- metal trimming knife
- clamp
- bevel
- tin snips
- power/battery/pneumatic tools and equipment:
 - bench grinder
 - circular saw
 - reciprocating saw
 - sliding compound saw
 - jigsaw
 - angle grinder
 - mobile plane
 - laminate trimmer or router
 - drill
 - rotary hammer drill
 - impact driver
 - nail gun
 - extension lead
 - portable residual current device
 - air compressor and hoses
- processes to safely grind, sharpen and hone a hand plane blade and a chisel.

Assessment Conditions
