New unit of competency.

Performance Evidence

A person who demonstrates competency in this unit must satisfy all of the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, and must assemble (if required) and install three internal shopfitting units as follows:

- one counter
- one showcase
- and one from the following:
 - cabinet
 - wall unit
 - workstation.

In doing the above work, the person must:

- comply with safety requirements and health and safety regulations applicable to workplace operations
- apply organisational quality procedures and processes in the context of installing shopfitting units
- identify design, delivered assemblies, components, fittings and assembly diagram if required
- identify and select components and fittings to match locations in installed shopfitting units
- select and use processes, tools and equipment to install shopfitting units safely and efficiently
- safely and efficiently:
 - locate and install unit into place
 - install components and fittings and, where applicable, check for designed operation
- identify typical faults and problems that occur and action required to rectify them
- communicate with others to ensure safe and effective workplace operations.

Knowledge Evidence

A person demonstrating competency in this unit must demonstrate knowledge of:

- content of and terms and symbols used in relevant drawings and specifications
- contents of and terms used in job safety analyses (JSA) and safe work method statements (SWMS) for tasks
- installation processes for internal shopfitting units
- organisation's quality assurance requirements relating to installing internal shopfitting units
- workplace and equipment health and safety requirements relating to installing internal shopfitting units.

Assessment Conditions

Suitable assessment of performance requires:

- equipment and tools:
 - as listed in the range of conditions
- materials:
 - three internal shopfitting units as listed in the range of conditions, ready for installation
- specifications:
 - job requirements
 - JSA
 - SWMS
 - safety data sheets (SDS)
- physical conditions:
 - retail space suitable for installing shopfitting units
- relationships with team members and supervisor:
 - work may be completed as part of a team
- relationship with client:
 - consultation with client is required
- timeframe:
 - according to job requirements.

Assessor requirements

As a minimum, assessors must satisfy the assessor requirements in the Standards for Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) current at the time of assessment.
