Application

This unit of competency specifies the skills and knowledge required to follow work health and safety (WHS) requirements when conducting access consulting activities at client sites. It requires identifying mandatory WHS duty of care legislation and regulations and following specific site WHS requirements.

This unit is for individuals who work independently using specialised knowledge to conduct a range of access consulting services.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this unit at the time of publication.

| | 2.7 | Conduct all access consulting work activities on site according to relevant WHS regulatory and workplace requirements. |
