Performance Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the candidate must demonstrate evidence of performance of the following on at least two occasions.

- using effective communication techniques related to mediation, mentoring, collaboration and cooperation
- reporting on the achievement of work outcomes

Knowledge Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the depth of knowledge demonstrated must be appropriate to the job context of the candidate.

- organisation's policies and procedures related to coordinating a work team
- strategies for performance development in the workplace
- principles of effective team operation
- principles of conflict resolution

Assessment Conditions

Valid assessment of this unit requires a workplace environment or one that closely resembles normal work practice and replicates the range of conditions likely to be encountered when coordinating a work group, including coping with difficulties, irregularities and breakdowns in routine.
