Performance Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the candidate must demonstrate evidence of performance of the following on at least one occasion.

- accessing and reading workplace safety policies and procedures electronically or in hard copy, including regulatory requirements
- operating and checking basic equipment and activities for safety
- using equipment for the purpose and in the manner intended and authorised
- identifying faults and problems in equipment and procedures
- identifying workplace safety issues
- documenting hazards in clear language according to organisational guidelines
- using approved safe manual-handling techniques
- responding to safety issues by using personal protective clothing and equipment where necessary
- using first aid equipment where necessary
- communicating verbally with others to alert them to health and safety issues

Knowledge Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the depth of knowledge demonstrated must be appropriate to the job context of the candidate.

- legal rights of employees and employers in the workplace
- work health and safety procedures
- workplace hazards and associated risks
- meaning of workplace work health and safety symbols and signs

- designated workplace personnel responsible for work health and safety

Assessment Conditions

Evidence for assessment must be gathered over a significant period of time and in conjunction with evidence gathered for all other units that have a component of work health and safety. This may require opportunities for candidates to demonstrate performance in a number of locations or service areas in the organisation relevant to the range of responsibilities they may be given.

Valid assessment of this unit requires a workplace environment or one that closely resembles normal work practice and replicates the range of conditions likely to be encountered by an individual when following workplace safety procedures, including coping with difficulties, irregularities and changes to routine.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
