Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- use experimentation, practice, investigation and analysis to increase expertise with different techniques and media
- evaluate own expertise against personal aspirations
- develop a personalised style of drawing or visual representation that supports own professional creative work.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- explain how changing work contexts may impact on personal drawing styles
- describe techniques and devices to extend expertise in drawing and visual representation
- discuss physical properties and capabilities of a wide range of materials and tools used in drawing.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in creative arts industry environments. The assessment environment must include access to:

- drawing materials, tools and equipment.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
