Performance Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate the ability to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including evidence of the ability to:

• produce design specifications for at least two animation and digital visual effects projects that meet production requirements.

In the course of the above, the candidate must:

- present design specifications that are well documented and clearly presented, supported by research and experimentation
- generate different concepts for animation and digital visual effects that meet cost, technical and feasibility requirements, in collaboration with other team members
- conduct trials, research and experimentation in developing design concepts for animation and digital visual effects
- analyse and document research findings based on trials and experimentation for improving concept designs
- review design process for improvement.

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must be able to demonstrate knowledge to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including knowledge of:

- factors that impact on the design of animation and digital visual effects
- strategies to evaluate design process to improve techniques
- audience characteristics that influence production style, content and technique decisions
- costing requirements of productions
- processes for storyboard creation
- main requirements for a design specification.

Assessment Conditions

Skills in this unit must be demonstrated in a workplace or simulated environment where the conditions are typical of those in a working environment in this industry.

This includes access to:

- production documents
- software required to demonstrate the performance evidence.
