- roles and responsibilities of different personnel in television productions
- interactions between production assistants and technical crew prior to and during productions
- work health and safety and security requirements relating to a television production environment
- intellectual property rights and copyrights and how they relate to television productions
- verbal and non-verbal cues used in television productions
- common documentation filing formats used for television productions.
