Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- prepare source film footage for digitisation in line with instructions, taking care not to damage film
- operate telecine equipment and digital recording media to digitise film footage
- check picture and sound are synchronised in the digital recording
- follow procedures for completing workplace documentation
- work collaboratively with others to resolve technical issues associated with transferring film to digital format.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- outline roles and responsibilities of personnel involved in transferring film to digital formats
- explain the equipment required to transfer film to digital format
- describe film handling and care requirements
- explain techniques used to clean film and equipment
- explain the process for synchronising image and sound
- identify typical problems that arise in the context of transferring film to digital formats and briefly describe solutions.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in creative arts industry environments. The assessment environment must include access to:

- telecine equipment
- digital recording equipment
- film footage
- interaction with others.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
