#### **Performance Evidence**

The candidate must demonstrate the ability to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including evidence of the ability to:

 carry out at least two transmission operations according to different production requirements.

In the course of the above, the candidate must:

- produce required planning documentation
- prepare required transmission material
- set up and check recording equipment working to specifications
- confirm and apply production and transmission instructions and schedules
- record content for broadcast from feeds in collaboration with others
- confirm quality of audio and video feeds meets organisational standards
- cue and replay material to air
- prepare and store back-up recordings according to organisational standards
- complete workplace documentation.

### **Knowledge Evidence**

The candidate must be able to demonstrate knowledge to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including knowledge of:

- industry technical standards for common productions and transmissions
- project management tools associated with carrying out transmission operations
- · organisational standards and safety procedures for carrying out transmission operations
- roles and responsibilities of personnel in broadcast operations and production
- the relevance of time codes, durations and cue points for video recording
- methods to ensure equipment and video formats are compatible, and for converting incompatible source materials
- strategies to resolve typical problems that may arise in the context of transmission operations

- process for reviewing quality of video and audio feeds
- typical procedures for backing up and storing recordings.

#### **Assessment Conditions**
