Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to plan, create and perform solo and group dance pieces.

The unit applies to those who are dancers performing for dance-school productions and other non-professional contexts in dance styles including tap, jazz, contemporary, street and cultural forms of dance. Work is usually undertaken with some supervision, though autonomy and judgement can be expected given the nature of the creative process.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this unit at the time of publication.

1. Create and prepare to perform dance pieces	1.1 Clarify purpose and intention of performance and dance piece with required personnel 1.2 Use variety of sources to generate ideas and determine stimuli for dance piece 1.3 Select ideas according to intention of dance piece and translate intention into choreographic plan 1.4 Identify dance forms and structures to be included in choreographic plan using creativity and improvisation 1.5 Refine and improve choreographic plan using rehearsal time, confirming that safe dance practices are followed 1.6 Seek and implement feedback from required personnel on dance

2. Create production elements to accompany dance pieces	2.1 Establish and source audiovisual requirements that support mood and effect of performance on audience 2.2 Confirm lighting and vision systems meet purpose and intention of performance and dance piece 2.3 Agree with required personnel on costuming, make-up and hair styling that will enhance audience experience and aesthetic qualities of performance 2.4 Determine and organise sets and props according to purpose and intention of performance 2.5 Arrange stage markings to reflect choreographic plan
3. Perform dance pieces	3.1 Control physical movement techniques according to choreographic plan for dance piece 3.2 Recall and execute dance sequences, structures and spatial relationships according to choreographic plan 3.3 Demonstrate flow, phrasing and dynamics in line with intention of dance piece 3.4 Maintain focus throughout performance and communicate and interact with other dancers as required 3.5 Demonstrate expression and engagement with audience using performance skills
4. Evaluate dance pieces	4.1 Develop a journal detailing composition process for reflection and analysis 4.2 Compare work to own existing work and assess development of own techniques and ideas 4.3 Discuss strengths and weaknesses of dance piece with required personnel and identify strategies for improvement
