## Performance Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate the ability to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including evidence of the ability to:

- dress at least two performers per performance in at least two different performances.

In the course of the above, the candidate must:

- interpret dressing requirements and dress performers to meet those requirements
- meet production deadlines
- handle costumes with care
- work cooperatively with others involved in productions.

## Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must be able to demonstrate knowledge to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including knowledge of:

- required behaviour and protocols in relation to dressing performers
- production schedule terminology
- format and meaning of production documentation used by dressers
- work health and safety (WHS) regulations relating to the role of dressers.

## Assessment Conditions

Skills in this unit must be demonstrated in a workplace or simulated environment where the conditions are typical of those in a working environment in this industry.

This includes access to:

- costumes and accessories to dress performers.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational education and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
