Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- determine the most efficient way to construct costume components to meet functional and production requirements
- develop and follow a sequence of operations for constructing a variety of costume components
- use a sewing machine competently and safely
- sew and finish costume components that meet functional requirements and costume production deadlines
- document the process of constructing costume components.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- identify sources of supply for materials typically required for construction of costume components
- outline roles and responsibilities of personnel involved in costume design and construction
- explain properties and characteristics of a range of fabrics typically used to construct costume components
- identify typical problems that arise in the context of constructing costume components and briefly describe solutions
- outline typical costume components
- explain functionality in relation to costumes for performance
- describe safety procedures that apply to using equipment and machinery to make costume components.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in creative arts industry environments. The assessment environment must include access to:

- notions, fabric and equipment used to produce costume components
- productions for which costume components need to be constructed
- costume specifications.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
