Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- interpret production documentation, plan, set up and operate off-site costume services
- follow workplace procedures for documenting the condition of costume items before transport and after arrival on site
- supervise off-site costume operations
- check continuity of costumes is maintained during productions
- efficiently resolve costume problems that arise during productions
- supervise the process of packing and transporting equipment and costumes at the conclusion of productions.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- explain administrative procedures associated with providing off-site costume services
- describe roles and responsibilities of personnel involved in off-site costume operations
- identify typical problems that arise in context of managing an off-site costume department and briefly describe solutions
- describe safety and security procedures that apply to providing off-site costume services.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in creative arts industry environments. The assessment environment must include access to:

- productions that require an off-site costume department

- materials and equipment required to manage costume services
- costumes and accessories.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
