Application

This unit describes the performance outcomes, skills and knowledge required to build a solid foundation in ballet dance technique under the supervision of experienced dancers and dance teachers.

Usually, experience would have been gained in dance classes, amateur performances or community dance activities, often from an early age. However, this unit also applies to individuals with no prior training, but with an aptitude for dance and an interest in developing classical ballet technique.

4. Review performance	<p>4.1 Evaluate own performance in context of skill development needs</p> <p>4.2 Use feedback from others to identify and develop ways to improve own dance technique</p> <p>4.3 Set realistic goals for improvement and develop strategies to achieve them</p>
