Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- perform barre and centre exercises
- perform two dances of differing tempos and styles that demonstrate a mastery of foundation tap dance techniques
- respond to constructive feedback on own performance.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided for each of the above points at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements the individual must:

- explain why the following aspects of safe dance practices are important:
 - warm-up and warm-down activities
 - correct clothing and footwear
 - healthy nutrition and diet
- describe key features in the history of tap dance styles and the music tempos typically associated with them.

Assessment Conditions

Gather evidence to demonstrate consistent performance in conditions that are safe and replicate the workplace. Noise levels, production flow, interruptions and time variances must be typical of those experienced in a dance learning environment. The assessment environment must include access to appropriate dance performance areas or spaces.

Assessors must satisfy NVR/AQTF assessor requirements.
