Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- perform a range of street dance movements
- perform two dance sequences that demonstrate a mastery of foundation street dance techniques
- respond to constructive feedback on own performance
- follow safe dance practices.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided for each of the above points at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements the individual must:

- explain why the following aspects of safe dance practices are important:
 - warm-up and warm-down activities
 - correct clothing and footwear
 - healthy nutrition and diet
- describe:
 - how street dance evolved
 - current music and dance trends in street dance.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in creative arts industry environments. The assessment environment must include access to appropriate dance performance areas or spaces.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
