Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- consistently execute well-developed social dance techniques
- execute dance sequences that demonstrate:
 - creative response to music
 - partnering skills
 - ability to communicate the mood or style of dances
- respond to constructive feedback on own skills development
- follow safe dance practices
- use social dance terminology correctly.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided for each of the above points at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements the individual must:

- explain how the following principles relate to physical movements and social dance techniques:
 - relationship with gravity
 - spatial awareness
 - successional movement
 - use of breath
 - folding

- extending
- rotating
- shifting weight
- explain how the following apply in the context of safe dance practice and injury prevention:
 - articulation of the spine
 - engagement of the feet
 - bases of support, including feet, legs, hands, arms and torso
 - range of motion of the joints
 - differentiation of the legs and pelvis
 - healthy nutrition and diet
- explain and demonstrate how the musical elements of time signatures, beat, tempo and syncopation apply to social dance technique
- describe the characteristics and history of chosen social dance styles.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in creative arts industry environments. The assessment environment must include access to appropriate dance performance areas or spaces with suitable flooring.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
