Performance Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate the ability to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including evidence of the ability to:

• produce interactive media sequences according to at least two different project requirements.

In the course of the above, the candidate must:

- assemble text content, interactive media components and media assets
- use applicable software to meet design and project specifications within deadlines
- apply visual design principles, templates, style sheets and mark-up language to interactive sequences
- adopt safe ergonomic practices when using screens and keyboards
- check interactive sequence functionality on at least two operating systems, browsers and devices
- save and store files according to organisational policies and procedures.

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must be able to demonstrate knowledge to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including knowledge of:

- applicable file formats for web delivery
- requirements for the optimisation of media assets when authoring interactive sequences
- importance of applying accessibility standards in the web environment
- basic visual design principles as they apply to website page layout
- safe work practices in relation to working on computers for periods of time
- procedures for checking copyright clearance.

Assessment Conditions

Skills in this unit must be demonstrated in a workplace or simulated environment where the conditions are typical of those in a working environment in this industry.

This includes access to:

- text and media assets
- authoring software.
