Performance Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate the ability to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including evidence of the ability to:

- plan and produce technically proficient digital images according to at least three different ideas.

In the course of the above, the candidate must:

- examine the combination of ideas and techniques in own digital image work in a discussion with others
- use materials and resources safely and sustainably
- evaluate own work progress and identify one or more areas for improvements in creative processes and products.

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must be able to demonstrate knowledge to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including knowledge of:

- historical and theoretical digital imaging practices applicable to the specific production of digital images
- capabilities of different materials, tools and equipment used in digital imaging
- elements and principles of design and their application to digital imaging
- common techniques used in producing digital images and how they can be adapted to achieve creative effects
- basic intellectual property considerations in producing creative works
- procedures for working safely with digital imaging materials, tools and equipment.

Assessment Conditions

Skills in this unit must be demonstrated in a workplace or simulated environment where the conditions are typical of those in a working environment in this industry.

This includes access to:

- tools, equipment and materials required for producing digital images
- applicable information sources.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
