## **Application**

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to analyse dance movements and apply the concepts and terminology of music to dance performances.

The unit applies to those who are dancers, choreographers and dance teachers exploring the relationship between music and dance in the context of teaching dance, improving their own dance technique, devising dance sequences or reviewing dance performances. While supervision is provided, autonomy and judgement can be expected during the process of reflecting and analysing performances.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this unit at the time of publication.

	3.3 Interpret rhythm from written notation and observe accented beats in responding to performances
	3.4 Identify choreographic devices that have been used to structure dance pieces and evaluate their effectiveness in meeting the demands of the music
	3.5 Compile an assessment of the relationship between the use of music and a dance work narrative in the required format
	3.6 Seek feedback from required personnel on own ability to detail the relationship between music and dance and identify areas for future improvement
