Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- use scripts as the basis for compiling character profiles
- manage scheduling and advertising of auditions, and distribution of information to applicants
- communicate character requirements clearly to performers auditioning for roles
- conduct auditions in a way that brings out the best in performers
- assess and select performers based on established performance criteria
- notify unsuccessful applicants and complete contractual arrangements with successful applicants.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- outline different ways actors approach character development
- describe techniques for creating an audition environment conducive to optimum performance by performers
- explain circumstances where call backs, additional auditions and screen tests would be used
- identify typical problems that arise during the auditioning and selection process and briefly describe solutions.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in creative arts industry environments. The assessment environment must include access to:

- audition venues and equipment
- screen productions for which auditions are required
- script materials
- performers.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
