Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- interpret screen production scripts from the perspective of devising camera coverage
- collaborate with production personnel to arrive at approaches to camera coverage that meet creative and technical criteria
- develop documentation that outlines approaches to camera coverage
- outline strategies for visualising written narratives in draft camera plans, incorporating input from production personnel
- communicate and negotiate effectively with creative and production personnel during the process of developing, testing and finalising camera plans.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- outline typical ways of documenting camera plans
- explain how key production elements and photographic principles are taken into account when devising camera coverage
- describe roles and responsibilities of production personnel who need to be consulted during the process of devising camera coverage
- identify typical problems associated with devising camera coverage and briefly describe solutions
- describe visual story-telling techniques and ways of moving from a written to visual narrative.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in creative arts industry environments. The assessment environment must include access to:

- production documentation
- productions and production personnel.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
