## Performance Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate the ability to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including evidence of the ability to:

- source funding for at least one project.

In the course of the above, the candidate must:

- research funding sources
- develop viable funding proposals
- prepare and deliver project pitch using effective presentation strategies and communication techniques
- interpret funding agreements.

## Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must be able to demonstrate knowledge to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including knowledge of:

- potential funding sources and channels through which they are publicised
- project proposal information required to support request for funding
- key features of a project pitch
- issues and challenges that typically arise in the context of securing funding for projects and strategies to resolve them.

## Assessment Conditions

Skills in this unit must be demonstrated in a workplace or simulated environment where the conditions are typical of those in a working environment in this industry.

This includes access to:

- applicable sources of information to prepare and support funding proposals

- interaction with others to present funding proposal.
