- develop at least one career plan that incorporates the results of self-analysis and feedback from others.
- In the course of the above, the candidate must:
- use different methods to establish and build contacts applicable to professional career interests
- plan and create a skills portfolio using applicable presentation formats.

### **Knowledge Evidence**

The candidate must be able to demonstrate knowledge to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including knowledge of:

- sources of information about the industry and career possibilities
- · job roles and pathways into and within the industry
- components of a typical career plan
- information that should be included in a skills portfolio
- different presentation formats for skills portfolios and personal resumes.
