- provide examples of innovative and experimental techniques for creating production elements in selected area of expertise
- explain how lighting affects materials used to create production elements and provide examples of how to adapt techniques to take account of the effects of lighting
- describe ways of adapting construction methods for different production styles, genres and art forms
- describe techniques for testing finished and unfinished materials

- explain how copyright, moral rights and intellectual property issues affect the process of creating production elements
- provide examples of work health and safety and environmental regulations that affect the process of creating production elements.

#### **Assessment Conditions**

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in creative arts industry environments. The assessment environment must include access to production elements and a work space that allows for experimentation with techniques and materials.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
