Performance Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate the ability to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including evidence of the ability to:

- plan and supervise the installation of a lighting system for at least one production or event.

In the course of the above, the candidate must:

- document a work plan for implementing the lighting designs, that include contingency strategies
- apply effective problem-solving techniques to the process of installing lighting systems
- work collaboratively with lighting and production team during the planning and installation process

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must be able to demonstrate knowledge to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including knowledge of:

- techniques for planning work when installing lighting systems into venues
- ways to address issues and challenges that typically arise when installing lighting systems
- safety requirements when installing lighting systems for productions and events
- industry trends and developments that impact on lighting operations
- features of lighting control systems that include DMX control systems
- where to source lighting equipment and accessories
- use of lighting equipment and accessories to achieve different lighting effects.

Assessment Conditions

Skills in this unit must be demonstrated in a workplace or simulated environment where the conditions are typical of those in a working environment in this industry.

This includes access to:

- venues where lighting systems need to be installed for productions
- workplace documentation.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational education and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
