The candidate must demonstrate the ability to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including evidence of the ability to:

 hear, identify and reproduce at least three basic music structures in different musical pieces.

In the course of the above, the candidate must:

- use music terminology applicable to music structures and styles
- demonstrate aural recognition
- integrate feedback from others into evaluation of own aural skill development.

## **Knowledge Evidence**

The candidate must be able to demonstrate knowledge to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including knowledge of:

- · music structures for nominated music genres or styles
- uses of aural perception and recognition skills in music practice
- · rhythmic, melodic and harmonic structures in relation to aural skill development
- ways in which aural recognition and perception skills are used in practice
- strategies to evaluate and improve skill development and respond to feedback
- music writing conventions related to aural perception.

#### **Assessment Conditions**

Skills in this unit must be demonstrated in a workplace or simulated environment where the conditions are typical of those in a working environment in this industry.

This includes access to:

a selection of recorded or performed music for investigation and skill development

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• interaction with others required to demonstrate the performance evidence.
