Performance Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate the ability to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including evidence of the ability to:

- perform at least two music pieces using technology-based equipment.

In the course of the above, the candidate must:

- care for, move, install and connect equipment safely and according to product instructions
- practise producing sounds and sequences.

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must be able to demonstrate knowledge to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including knowledge of:

- ways that music technology can be used to:
 - reproduce and perform sounds and sequences
 - program music
- features of music technology-based equipment and software and their use in performances, including:
 - electronic devices
 - outboard equipment
 - related software
 - effects
- safe work practices applicable to music technology when used in performance
- ways to seek and incorporate feedback to improve performances.

Assessment Conditions

Skills in this unit must be demonstrated in a workplace or simulated environment where the conditions are typical of those in a working environment in this industry.

This includes access to:

- industry-standard technology-based equipment and related software
- at least one form of outboard equipment linked to a computer or other technology-based equipment.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
