Performance Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate the ability to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including evidence of the ability to:

• play or sing at least three different musical practice pieces using chosen instrument or voice.

In the course of the above, the candidate must:

- demonstrate technical requirements of performance repertoire, including:
 - control of agreed tempi and musical markings
 - intonation
 - rhythm
 - tone colour
- practise and play or sing a selected set of exercises or studies
- discuss strategies to improve own technical expertise.

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must be able to demonstrate knowledge to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including knowledge of:

- instrument or voice parts, physical characteristics, applications, range and capabilities
- methods for caring for voice or instrument
- processes for setting up and warming up voice or chosen instrument, including standard tuning conventions as required
- work health and safety (WHS) principles as they apply to playing or singing music
- strategies to evaluate and improve own performance and respond to feedback.

Assessment Conditions

Skills in this unit must be demonstrated in a workplace or simulated environment where the conditions are typical of those in a working environment in this industry.

This includes access to:

- instruments and equipment required to demonstrate the performance evidence
- suitable space to demonstrate skills on instrument or voice
- interaction with others required to demonstrate the performance evidence.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
