## Performance Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate the ability to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including evidence of the ability to:

- use personal practice time to achieve the musical and technical standard required for performances on at least three occasions.

In the course of the above, the candidate must:

- plan and develop performance pieces in consultation with appropriate people
- incorporate constructive criticism from others and own observations on own performance in practice sessions and rehearsals
- implement personal health and safety considerations during practice sessions.

## Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must be able to demonstrate knowledge to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including knowledge of:

- repertoire relevant to selected instrument and/or voice
- requirements when preparing for performances, including personal practice plans
- health and safety principles as they apply to correct posture and prevention of personal injury
- strategies and psychological tools to overcome performance anxiety
- techniques for incorporating and responding to feedback.

## Assessment Conditions

Skills in this unit must be demonstrated in a workplace or simulated environment where the conditions are typical of those in a working environment in this industry.

This includes access to:

- instruments and equipment required to demonstrate the performance evidence

- suitable practice or rehearsal space.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
