Prepare to use digital media in performances	2.1 Test and apply different techniques for using digital media in musical performance 2.2 Test different sounds that can be incorporated into own performance 2.3 Identify factors that may affect use of digital media in performance in consultation with required personnel

4. Review use of digital media in performances	4.1 Evaluate own use of digital media in performance and identify development areas 4.2 Seek and discuss feedback on using digital media from required personnel and develop strategies for future improvement
