## Performance Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate the ability to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including evidence of the ability to:

- perform at least three different musical pieces from written notation.

In the course of the above, the candidate must:

- follow conventions of selected music, adjusting own performance as required
- apply knowledge of style and genre to performance
- follow work health and safety (WHS) principles when reading music and performing.

## Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must be able to demonstrate knowledge to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including knowledge of:

- conventions of written music notation and how they are used in performance
- different musical genres and styles, and their musical forms and conventions in written notation
- ways to improve interpretation of notated music and music reading skills
- WHS principles that apply to reading and performing music
- issues and challenges that arise in context of performing music from written notation and strategies for overcoming them.

## Assessment Conditions

Skills in this unit must be demonstrated in a workplace or simulated environment where the conditions are typical of those in a working environment in this industry.

This includes access to:

- a selection of notated music

- instruments, equipment and performance space required to demonstrate the performance evidence.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
