Performance Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate the ability to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including evidence of the ability to:

 process colour materials in a wet darkroom according to at least two different project requirements.

In the course of the above, the candidate must:

- organise darkroom work space for safe and efficient production of colour photographs
- handle pre-exposed film correctly and make proof sheets or work prints
- apply appropriate wet darkroom techniques to produce colour prints suitable for display or reproduction
- check, clean and store equipment according to workplace requirements.

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must be able to demonstrate knowledge to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including knowledge of:

- work space requirements for colour processing and printing techniques in a wet darkroom environment
- properties and capabilities of materials and equipment used to process and print colour negatives and transparencies
- techniques used for processing colour materials in a wet darkroom context and the different effects that can be achieved
- work health and safety procedures in relation to colour processing.

Assessment Conditions

Skills in this unit must be demonstrated in a workplace or simulated environment where the conditions are typical of those in a working environment in this industry.

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This includes access to:

- wet darkroom equipment and environment, including:
 - photographic printing materials
 - resources
 - · equipment for colour film processing and printing.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational education and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
