- document lighting experiments and store research materials and work samples appropriately.

- theories of light relevant to photo imaging
- uses and capabilities of photographic lighting equipment and accessories
- technology used to generate, harness and use lighting in photo imaging work
- lighting processes that create emotive and descriptive effects.
