The candidate must demonstrate the ability to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including evidence of the ability to:

- create a body of photo images experimenting with, and applying, at least two specialised imaging technologies around a specific theme or subject matter.

In the course of the above, the candidate must:

- document specialised imaging processes for use in future contexts
- evaluate own performance and identify one or more areas for improvement.

The candidate must be able to demonstrate knowledge to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including knowledge of:

- common specialised imaging technologies, their attributes and their applications
- opportunities offered by imaging technology to represent the subject matter in different ways
- work health and safety considerations associated with imaging technology.

Assessment Conditions

Skills in this unit must be demonstrated in a workplace or simulated environment where the conditions are typical of those in a working environment in this industry.

This includes access to:

- specialised image technologies
- credible sources of information on historical and contemporary imaging technology and techniques.
