## Performance Evidence

The candidate must demonstrate the ability to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including evidence of the ability to:

- make at least two different simple creative works using basic art and design techniques and tools, equipment and materials safely and sustainably.

In the course of the above, the candidate must:

- inform own creative work through process of collecting, organising and reviewing information
- discuss and communicate ideas and intent during creative process, using oral, visual and written means with required personnel
- clean and maintain work area, and tools and equipment used, in a safe and sustainable manner.

## Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must be able to demonstrate knowledge to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including knowledge of:

- sources of information on ideas and techniques for own creative work
- methods for developing, refining and communicating ideas for own creative work
- procedures for recycling and disposing of material used in creative process
- safety and sustainability requirements and procedures required for chosen area of creative practice.

## Assessment Conditions

Skills in this unit must be demonstrated in a workplace or simulated environment where the conditions are typical of those in a working environment in this industry.

This includes access to:

- tools, equipment and materials
- studio and/or workshop facilities.
- required information sources.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational education and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
