Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- rehearse a performance that meets the requirements of an auditioning body
- perform proficiently for either a real or simulated audition
- apply performance skills appropriate to audition
- communicate effectively with others involved in the audition.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided for each of the above points at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements the individual must:

- explain how the following apply in rehearsal and performance contexts:
 - protection of body against injury from overuse
 - safe lifting practices
- describe typical audition protocols
- demonstrate well-developed knowledge of:
 - repertoire being presented for audition
 - terminology and basic performance techniques relevant to own area of specialisation.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in creative arts industry environments. The assessment environment must include access to:

- relevant resources and equipment
- opportunities for auditions in either a real or simulated situation
- a venue with adequate space for solo or ensemble performances.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
