- explain ideas in a formal presentation.

# **Knowledge Evidence**

To complete the unit requirements the individual must:

- demonstrate knowledge of:
  - key characteristics of contemporary dance practice
  - protocols to be observed when collecting information of a culturally sensitive nature
  - work health and safety (WHS) issues in relation to working for long periods of time on computers
- explain how the following apply when using interviews to conduct research:
  - effective listening
  - questioning
  - non-verbal cues
- describe features of commonly used quantitative and qualitative research methodologies.

### Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in creative arts industry environments. The assessment environment must include access to:

- internet access
- computer with appropriate information collection software
- information sources.
