Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- develop substantiated positions on complex issues related to live performance practice
- research a broad range of new and emerging performance ideas and practices
- communicate ideas and theories to peers and colleagues.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided for each of the above points at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements the individual must:

- in the context of researching and applying concepts of live performance practice, demonstrate well-developed knowledge of:
 - aesthetics as a culturally-specific construct
 - current companies, directors and performers operating in the local and international
 - effective presentation techniques
 - research techniques
 - socio-cultural roles of performers in their respective environments and in the global marketplace
 - how creativity manifests in individuals and groups
 - fusion practices throughout history and in the current environment
- describe issues arising from the globalisation of culture
- describe the effect digital technology is having on live performance practice.

Assessment Conditions

Gather evidence to demonstrate consistent performance in conditions that are safe and replicate the workplace. Noise levels, production flow, interruptions and time variances must be typical of those experienced in a performance environment. The assessment environment must include access to current and emerging sources of information on live performance practice.

Assessors must satisfy NVR/AQTF assessor requirements.
