## **Performance Evidence**

Evidence of the ability to:

- construct a variety of set elements for at least one production
- follow safety procedures
- meet deadlines
- work collaboratively.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided for each of the above points at least once.

## **Knowledge Evidence**

To complete the unit requirements the individual must:

- describe issues and challenges that typically arise when constructing sets and suggest ways of addressing them
- describe how different materials, finishes and colours react under lighting and other production conditions
- explain how specifications and set designs in production documentation can be used as the basis for determining set construction techniques
- explain how legislative and organisational safety standards relate to the process of constructing sets
- describe techniques for constructing and painting sets and explain the different contexts in which they are used
- describe safe handling techniques for hazardous materials typically used in set construction
- explain how to test a range of finished and unfinished materials.

### **Assessment Conditions**

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in creative arts industry environments. The assessment environment must include access to:

- set specifications and drawings
- a venue in which sets can be constructed.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
