# **Performance Evidence**

Evidence of the ability to:

- document creative and technical requirements based on an analysis of production information in area of specialisation for at least two productions
- develop and implement work plans to achieve production requirements in area of specialisation on at least two occasions
- work collaboratively
- meet work deadlines.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided for each of the above points at least once.

# **Knowledge Evidence**

To complete the unit requirements the individual must:

- explain the purpose of a range of documentation required for the planning of work operations
- explain key factors involved in ensuring that work plans address production requirements in area of specialisation
- describe issues and challenges that can arise when developing and implementing work plans, along with solutions to address them
- describe broad historical and cultural context for productions relevant to area of specialisation.

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#### **Assessment Conditions**

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in creative arts industry environments. The assessment environment must include access to productions and production information from which to develop work plans.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
