Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- manage support services for at least two auditions in line with requirements
- communicate clearly and appropriately with members of audition panels and auditioning performers
- produce accurate documentation to support audition process and outcomes
- meet work deadlines
- work collaboratively.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided for each of the above points at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements the individual must:

- explain the purpose of a range of documentation required for the conduct of auditions
- describe how requirements of role differ, depending on the type of audition
- explain key factors involved in ensuring that auditions run smoothly
- describe issues and challenges that may arise when managing audition support services, along with solutions to address them
- explain key legislative requirements and codes of practice to be taken into account when organising audition support services.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in creative arts industry environments. The assessment environment must include access to audition facilities.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
