Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- in rehearsals, manage the integration of technical and creative components of at least two productions
- prepare and update stage management documentation
- apply knowledge of technical, staging and artistic aspects of productions to the stage management process
- meet work deadlines
- work collaboratively
- delegate tasks to team members.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided for each of the above points at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements the individual must:

- explain the purpose of a range of documentation used for stage managing technical and dress rehearsals
- explain key factors involved in the successful stage management of technical and dress rehearsals
- describe issues and challenges that can arise when stage managing technical and dress rehearsals, along with solutions to address them
- explain health and safety legislation and regulations that apply to maintaining a safe working environment during rehearsals.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in creative arts industry environments. The assessment environment must include access to rehearsal rooms and venues with stage and backstage areas.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
